- ☐ Have a three month review to see how it is going.

News Team

What does the news team do?

The news is a 3-5 minute slot during our Sunday gatherings. The person doing news that week is usually given 2-4 news items to share with the church.

The news slot is an important part of our mornings where we demonstrate Jesus' love by welcoming everyone, especially those who may be new. It's also a time to share key information about how people can connect with each other and get involved in the life of Hope church e.g. events and midweek groups.

How old do I have to be? What kind of person are you looking for?

At least 8 years old. We are looking for someone who:

- Enjoys speaking in front of others
- Is friendly and welcoming
- Wants to help the church know what's going on throughout the week/month
- Wants to grow in confidence and learn how to communicate well

What would I do?

- Spend some time in the week practicing what you're saying
- Pray with the wider serving team

What is the time commitment?

- Arrive at 9.45am for prayer. The news slot usually starts around 11.10ish and takes about 5 mins. It happens just after Hope Kids go out. Once you've shared the news, you are free to head out to your group if it's happening or to stay for the preach.

Seedlings

HopeKids Team

What does the Seedlings team do?

Seedlings is our room for two to three year olds on a Sunday morning. The team's job is to love and play with the children, and help them be safe, and connect with God.

How old do I have to be? What kind of person are you looking for?

At least 8 years old. We are looking for someone who:

- Loves caring for small children
- Wants children to know God
- Wants to learn how to lead well
- Can be gentle and careful

What would I do?

- Help set up the room and pray with the team
- Pray with the wider serving team
- Help children to feel welcome in their groups and feel safe that they have a friend
- Help children do the activities and play and pray with them
- Help tidy up

What is the time commitment?

- 9.30am for set up, team prayers, rejoin your parents from 10am until 11.15 when Hope Kids begins. Rejoin the team at the end of the service for set down. Typically finish around 12.15 but this can vary depending on the time the kids are collected.

Rooted HopeKids Team

What does the Rooted team do?

- Wants children to know God
- Wants to learn how to lead well

- Help children do the activities and play and pray with them

Connected HopeKids Team

What does the Connected team do?

Connected is our room for our younger primary kids on a Sunday morning. The team's job is to help the kids to connect with God themselves through crafts, games, reading the bible and exploring who that passage shows us God is.

How old do I have to be? What kind of person are you looking for?

At least 11 years old. We are looking for someone who:

- Loves caring for children
- Wants children to know God
- Wants to learn how to lead well

What would I do?

- Help set up the room and pray with the team
- Pray with the wider serving team
- Help children to feel welcome in their groups and feel safe that they have a friend
- Help children do the activities, crafts, engage in the bible and connect to God themselves
- Help tidy up

What is the time commitment?

- 9.30am for set up, team prayers, rejoin your parents from 10am until 11.15 when Hope Kids begins. Rejoin the team at the end of the service for set down. Typically finish around 12.15 but this can vary depending on the time the kids are collected.

Visuals Team

What does the visuals team do?

Runs the vision element of the service, assisting people to engage with the words of the worship and interact with the visual parts of the sermon.

How old do I have to be? What kind of person are you looking for?

At least 12 years old to do it alone for the whole service. If you are 10 years old, there will be a role for you to learn and do the visuals for the initial part of the service. We are looking for someone who:

- Has attention to detail and is not distracted easily
- Is able to listen well and take direction
- Works well under pressure and is a problem solver
- Likes computers and likes being behind the scenes

What would I do?

- Prepare the visuals on the computer— load the slides and videos, this is done in the week before and initially will take around an hour but longer term will take half an hour
- Pray with the wider serving team
- Throughout the service listen to what is happening up front both in worship and in the service and keep the slides and videos current
- Ensure the laptop is handed on to the team member for next week

What is the time commitment?

- 9am to 12.20pm
- Half an hour to an hour midweek

Streaming Team

What does the visuals team do?

Video and livestreams our Hope gathering each week, so that those who are unable to attend physically are still able to access it.

Enables people who are not part of our church to hear about Jesus, and provides a window into church life for those who may want to attend church.

How old do I have to be? What kind of person are you looking for?

Over 8

- Someone who enjoys videography or technology.
- Someone who is willing to serve.
- Willing to learn

What would I do?

- Unpack the streaming boxes and set up the equipment beforehand, and pack away afterwards.
- Operate the streaming equipment and software throughout the gathering.
- We have a detailed training session and training guide to facilitate easy learning and application of all tasks, making this a fun activity and great way to serve.

What is the time commitment?

- There is one person on team each week
- Once a month
- 9:15am - 12:15pm

Welcome Team

What does the welcome team do?

The welcome team wants everyone who comes to church to feel like they belong here, and are loved and can find friends.

How old do I have to be? What kind of person are you looking for?

At least 10 years old to do it on your own.

We are looking for someone who:

- Likes smiling at people and welcoming them
- Can ask people questions
- Is kind and generous with their time
- Can think of how to help people meet each other

What would I do?

- Set up banners and welcome table
- Pray with the wider team
- Greet people at the door take them to the refreshment area
- Look for any lost or alone people to help them connect with others
- Help families and children know where to register
- Set down banners
- Ensure the auditorium is tidy

What is the time commitment?

- 9.30am for set up, prayer as a wider serving team, finish any more setup needed, be at the door to greet and welcome, rejoin your parents during worship. Set down and clear up after the service which usually finishes around to 12:45pm

Worship Team

(Musicians and Singers)

What does the worship team do?

Leads and plays music at services to help people have a dynamic and engaging way of meeting with God. We connect with God ourselves, follow what God is doing in the service, and respond to it alongside the congregation.

How old do I have to be? What kind of person are you looking for?

At least 10 years old. We are looking for someone who:

- Loves God and loves worshipping Him in all of life
- Is confident at playing or singing, and can provide evidence of learning/developing their skill (eg having music lessons for their instrument). There is no sheet music provided, so looking for someone who is comfortable with chords.
- Likes to serve

What would I do?

- Come early to setup
- Rehearse
- Pray with the wider serving team
- Lead with the team throughout the gathering
- Set down at the end of the gathering

What is the time commitment?

- 8.30am until 12:30pm

Set Up Team

What does the set up team do?

Transforms Ashville from a school venue to a place of worship where everyone is free from distractions and able to focus on and enjoy Jesus. Supports and protects other teams and members of the body by retrieving their resources from the stage entrance and helping them set up and pack down safely.

Helps Sunday's run smoothly so that everyone is able to enjoy Jesus together, and each team is able to focus on their roles.

How old do I have to be? What kind of person are you looking for?

At least 12 years old. We are looking for someone who:

- Loves God and wants to release the whole family to worship God
- Likes to serve-practically help others

What would I do?

- Arrive at 8:30 to start set up.
- Set up Ashville for the gathering
- Pack down Ashville at the end of the gathering

What is the time commitment?

- 8.30am until 1pm

Hope Kids Tech Team

What does the Hope Kids Tech Team do?

Sets up Hope Kids Registration and the Comets Room to enable the safe registering of all the children attending Hope Kids and creating space for kids with additional needs to feel safe at Hope.

How old do I have to be? What kind of person are you looking for?

At least 10 years old to do this alone but anyone from 8 with an adult could do this role. We are looking for someone who:

- Loves God and wants to practically serve the church family
- Loves technology
- Doesn't get stressed when technology goes wrong

What would I do?

- Arrive at 9.15 to start set up.
- Set up Registration laptop, tablets and the Comets Room before the gathering
- Packs down the registration laptop, collects the tablets and packs away the Comets Room at the end of the morning.

What is the time commitment?

- 9.15am until 12.30pm
